

## Summer Camp Scholarships Available

Summer camp scholarships are available to income-eligible children through Volusia County's Community Assistance Division.

Families with children who are entering first through sixth grade **and** are between the ages of 5 and 12 are eligible. Five-year-olds are eligible only if they have completed kindergarten. Persons with special needs enrolled in school up to and including high school are eligible. Scholarship awards are based on income eligibility and will be awarded according to funding availability.

Scholarship applications will be available beginning on March 21, 2017, at all Volusia County Public Libraries; approved camp sites; and the Human Services offices at 123 W. Indiana Ave., Room 101, DeLand; 250 N. Beach St., Room 100, Daytona Beach; 107 E. Canal St., New Smyrna Beach; and 775 Harley Strickland Blvd., Suite 104, Orange City. Applications will also be posted online at [www.volusia.org/community\\_assistance/applications](http://www.volusia.org/community_assistance/applications).
